1860 Tulare CA, twp 3. John Whittaker (52, rancher, OH), Julia Whittaker (37, AR), William Whittaker (18, AR), Seaburn Geter (14, AR), Adolphus Geter (12, AR), S__teburg (Littlebury?) Geter (7, CA), Henry Share (7, CA), Frank Whitaker (1, CA). Henry is Julia's nephew, son of Miranda and Henry Share.

1869 city directory for San Francisco (accessed at ancestry.com) — Henry P Share, clerk with George S. Dickey, dwl S Stockton.

1870 San Francisco CA, 2d pct, PO 406 Montgomery St. Boarding house -- Jane McQuinn (82, Scotland), George S Dickey (druggist, 40, MD), Myra (37, AR), Henry Share (17, apprentice engraver, CA) (and several others). Myra here is Miranda Sinclair Share, now married to George Dickey. Confirmed by death notice of her sister Julia Whitaker.

Henry is enumerated twice in 1870 San Francisco -- 6th ward. Warren C Butler (43, wood engraver, NY), Margaret (41, Eng), John J (22, works in mint, NY), Henry C (18, carpenter, NY), Theodore A (15, app to engraver (NY), Emma (12, CA), Warren (9, CA), Irwin (4, CA), Henry P Share (16, app to engraver, CA), Ah Kee (12, dom. servant, China). Butler has a bio in Artists in California, 1786-1940. He was an engraver for the mint in the 1860s and a cable car conductor in 1870s. Died in 1879.

1873 Pacific Coast Business Directory (San Francisco) (@ ancestry) -- Henry P Share, designer and engraver with Francis & Valentine, dwl 1013 Mission.

Sometime between 1873 and 1878, Henry made his way from San Francisco to New York.

1905 census, Kings Co, NY, Brooklyn, Winthrope St. Henry P Share (61, US, artist), Selena V (55). Next to Edward A Kracke (21, real estate), Leonora S (20). This census is dated June 1, 1905, so taken just before Henry died.

Obituary in New York Times, June 22, 1905: Henry Pruett Share, newspaper artist, died on Tuesday at his home, 16 Winthrop Street, Flatbush. He was born fifty-two years ago in Los Angeles, Cal., and was at one time art editor of The New York Herald and later of The New York World. He leaves a widow, one son, and a daughter. His funeral will be held this afternoon at his home. The burial will be in Trinity Cemetery, One Hundred and Fifty-fifth Street, Manhattan.

Obituary in New York Tribune, June 22, 1905, p. 8 (available via chroniclingamerica.loc.gov) -- Henry Pruett Share, a well known artist and newspaper man, died yesterday at his home, No. 14 Winthrop St., Flatbush, after an illness of six weeks. He was fifty-two years old and was born in Los Angeles Cal. Share had been art editor of The New York Herald and of the The New York World. He was on the art staff of The New York American at the time of his death. He leaves a wife, one son, Henry Pruett Share Jr, and one daughter, Mrs. Edward A. Kracke. The funeral will be held today at 10am at his home, the Rev. Dr. Britton of Trinity Church officiating. He will be buried in Trinity Cemetery, at 13_ St and Amsterdam Ave.

The will of H Pruett Share was recorded May 11, 1905, witnessed by George Tiffany (178 Hawthorne St, Brooklyn) , Edward A Kracke (169 Hawthorne St), and Eliza Tiffany (178 Hawthorne St). He leaves all his estate to his wife Selena V Share. He is from Brooklyn, Kings Co. NY. (accessed @ ancestry, NY Wills and Probate Records, Kings County, v. 345-347, p. 284-289]

Pruett Share, as he often signed his works, was a noted engraver and illustrator working in New York. A Google search of his name today retrieves numerous references to his works. His father-in-law Arthur Waud was also a noted artist. Short bios appear in "Artists in California 1786-1940" by Edan Milton Hughes and Who Was Who in American Art.

This info found online (not verified) -- included here for the indication that he must have arrived in NY by 1871.

Share was a founder of the Salmagundi Club in 1871 and remained a member until his death. He is represented in the club's 1881 portfolio of etchings. Share was born in Los Angeles but moved to NYC as a young man, a necessary move for an aspiring artist. He exhibited with the NY etching Club in 1886, 1887, and 1888, becoming a resident member in 1888.

Obituary published Apr 10, 1891 in New York Times for Alfred R. Waud -- He was an illustrator and a war artist for Harper's Weekly during the Civil War. Born in London. Leaves 3 daughters, two of whom married artists, H. Pruett Share and Milton J. Burns. (Burns was a noted maritime artist.)

Brooklyn Life, 2 Jan 1904, accessed @ newspapers.com — “Of particular interest to the Flatbush section is the announcement of the engagement of Miss Leonora Share, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. H. Pruett Share, of 84 Winthrop street, Flatbush, to Mr. Edward H. Kracke. Miss Share, whose father, I need not say, is well known as an illustrator and etcher, is a former Packer student, while her fiancé is a Harvard man of the class of '03. Both are members of the Knickerbocker Field Club.”

Marriage date is from a snippet from a Harvard publication found via Google Books, clearly about Edward Kracke -- Secretary's Second Report by Harvard College (1780-). Class of 1907, 1910 - 88 pages.
